THE CORNER CAMARO

This months' Corner Camaro is EMCC member Chuck England's 1971 RS! My interest in Camaros started way back in 1969 when I first saw a brand new shiny Z-28. Although I was only 12 at the time, I knew that was the car I had to have. Fast forward to 1973, I saw a 1972 Z28 on a used car lot at Lou LaRiche Chevrolet and a few days later, it was mine. I drove that car for a couple of years then sold it to purchase a 1969 project car. Life changed, kids work etc. and I never finished it, sold it in pieces. Fast forward to 2010, our good friends Snook and Kathy Denski, had been talking about this great Camaro club they were involved in and I began to get the bug again for a Camaro, really wanted to look for an early 2nd generation. I think Roxanne, Kathy, Snook and I visited every state in the Midwest and found nothing but duds that didn't fit our requirements. Unknowing to me, Roxanne was looking for a car on her own and found a 1971 at PJ's Auto World in Clearwater Florida. It was supposed to be a surprise however, fearing it was another dud and after much persuasion, Snook said he was going to look at it with or without me. We flew down to look at it in June 2011. When we arrived at Pj's it was up on a hoist and it only took all of 5 minutes to know that it was the one. Paid for it on the spot and had it shipped, arriving in Plymouth on July 1, 2010. I washed it up the next day and drove it to our first EMCC Camaro Superfest taking 2nd place in the judging. Our 1971 RS with original A/C was a rotisserie restoration, but lacking in the mechanical department. Over the years, I have rebuilt the motor to 355CID/350HP, added a new Tremic 5 speed transmission, Holley Atomic EFI, replaced much of the interior, cowl induction hood, Magna flow exhaust and a few other upgrades.

Since 2011, we have taken it to every Superfest where it has won several awards. We loved participating in many of the EMCC events through the year with it. We have had a lot of fun with this car and hope to continue enjoying it for many more years to come. I give THANKS to Roxanne for finding it and to Snook for talking me into going to Florida to look at it. GREAT Camaro Chuck! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!
